The Miskatonic Project : The Whisperer In Darkness (graphic novel)

Set in 1928, the graphic novel introduces members of the Miskatonic Project, three paranormal investigators who have experienced horrific brushes with the Great Old Ones in the past, including Cthulhu.

Lord Justin Sabbath, Professor Augustus Grant and celebrity psychic Fleur Avignon use the Miskatonic University as a base of operations. They battle to prevent the ruthless, alien Mi-Go from turning humanity into soulless vessels who live only to serve their dark god, Cthulhu.

The graphic novel features an adaptation of H.P. Lovecraft's "The Whisperer In Darkness" by noted Lovecraft illustrator, Daryl Hutchinson, and a sequel to the events of story penciled by legendary Marvel Comics artist Don Heck and Darryl Banks, who also rendered the cover.
